Terms and conditions

Organiser

- A 25% deposit must be received with all bookings, unless otherwise agreed.
- The balance of payment is due on arrival at the event on presentation of invoice. This will include mileage charged at £1 per mile per vehicle from CT3 2AF to venue and return and will be checked on www.theaa.com
- The Event Organiser is responsible for ensuring adequate access to the event site.
- The responsibility for locating the display appropriately at the event lies with the Event Organiser.
- The Event Organiser accepts responsibility, following his choice of location, for ensuring that the conditions are suitable for unloading and loading and will provide assistance should a change in weather conditions create problems with loading.
- The Event Organiser will provide a minimum of six persons to assist with unloading and assembly of the exhibits on arrival at the event as booked and assist with dismantling and loading immediately following event closure. This will take a maximum of 20-minutes per plane.
- The Event Organiser is to provide overnight security for the aircraft/exhibition.
- Secure parking to be provided for the transport trailer(s) for the duration of the event.
- Where the Battle of Britain Experience is booked for more than one day, the Event Organiser will provide overnight accommodation for the driver at the Organiser's cost. Should any further War and Peace personnel be required this will be at an additional cost, which will include accommodation.
- In the event of the booking being cancelled by the Event Organiser with less than 28 days' notice, the deposit will be non-refundable. The Event Organiser may be liable for any costs incurred by the team, for example, accommodation deposits, etc.

Terms and conditions

- The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience will provide the Event Organiser with a generic risk assessment for the exhibition.
- The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience will provide a copy of public liability insurance.
- The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience will take responsibility for overseeing the assembly and dismantling of the aircraft/exhibit with the assistance of event personnel.
- The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience will take responsibility for cordoning off the exhibit(s) out of hours if the Event Organiser has not provided suitable barriers.
- In the unlikely eventuality of The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience withdrawing from the event for any reason then the deposit will be returned in full.
- If acceptable to the Event Organiser, The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience may sell related merchandising, which may include charity raffle tickets in support of Help for Heroes.
- The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience can offer the opportunity to purchase individual photographs with the exhibits, which will be provided at time of purchase.
- The War and Peace Battle of Britain Experience will publicise the event on The War and Peace website, Twitter and Facebook pages.
